 - (c) Handmade picture any medium max. **60cms x 45cms (excluding frame)**.
 - (d) Bouquet or tied bunch of fresh garden flowers **or** six Sweet Pea
 - (e) Two types of Vegetables (3 per type) **excluding Potatoes**
2. If a Dundee Cake is entered a **20cm** (8 inch) **round** or **18cm** (7 inch) **square** tin must be used.

If an item of hand knitting, crochet or embroidery is entered, a sample of yarn used to make the item **must accompany the entry**.

If a picture is entered, the picture **must be handmade**. Machine work will **not suffice**.

All vegetables/flowers must be grown by the exhibitor.
3. **Exhibitors may qualify once only.**
4. Two exhibitors to qualify from each qualifying show.
5. This competition will be judged on a points system.
6. **Points will be awarded for presentation.**
